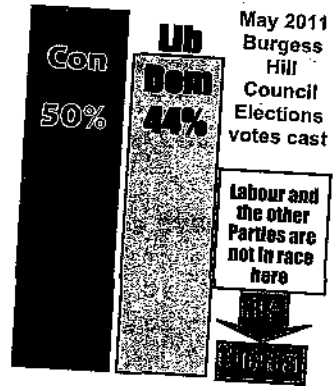

Meeds North Ward By-Election

10th May

There is to be a by-election on 10th May. This follows the resignation of the Tory councillor in Meeds North Ward.

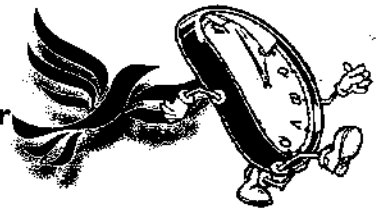
